

Race Format and Scale of Prize Money in Dutch Open Grass Track 2018

Race format:

Solo

15 riders + 2 substitutes from the KNMV national Specials class

5 riders per heat

4 qualifying heats, Last Chance (B-Final) and A-Final

Sidecars

10 outfits + 2 substitutes (if possible)

Substitutes will receive travel expenses and can participate at practice.

5 outfits per heat

4 qualifying heats, Last Chance (B-Final) and A-Final

Scale of Prize Money

Prize money: € 10,00 per point

Per heat point scoring is: 4-3-2-1-0

No points or prize money in Last Chance heat (B-Final)

All points scored in the separate heats (except Last Chance B-final) will count for the championship (like Long Track GP)

At the end of the season the top 5 of both Solo and Sidecar competition will receive a lump sum of prize money. This prize money is only reimbursed to those who have participated in the full competition (all races)

2^e place: € 600,00

3^e place: € 400,00

4^e place: € 300,00

5^e place: € 200,00

Sidecar – 5 events

1^e place: € 1000,00

2^e place: € 600,00

Travel expenses foreign participants per event:

€ 150,00 for participants from Belgium, Germany and Denmark

€ 250,00 for participants from England, France, Sweden, Finland, Baltic States etc

MX transponder in Grass Track

The use of a MX transponder is obligatory in the Dutch Open Grass Track. KNMV will lend this transponders to foreign participants. The transponder should be returned to timekeeping at the end of the race day.
